Get ready for a Saluki summer!

Now that the Saluki Long Course Invitational is over we are starting to gear up for the summer session. As with all summer sessions there are changes from what most swimmers in the club are used to throughout the year. For almost every swimmer there are changes in practice times, pools and other items.

Technique focus

The major change that we will see this summer though is one of emphasis on training or technique. For those attending meets with Saluki this summer the training program will follow the traditional plan. For those not attending meets this summer or those just competing in summer league meets our focus will be on technique.

Pool changes

Swimmers in the Age Group 2 and Age Group 1 squads will train at the SRC pool beginning on Monday, 4 June. Jedi swimmers will continue practicing at Pulliam pool.

Age Group 1 and 2 swimmers must let us know if they will be swimming with the club this summer. Arrangements must be made beforehand to allow them to enter the SRC building. Simply showing up will not work. Any AG1 or AG2 swimmer planning on swimming this summer should **call Saluki HQ (457-1103)** and let us know so these arrangements can be made.

Time changes

Along with the pool changes there will also be changes in times for many swimmers. Here is the summer practice schedule:

- Saturday practices are not held during the summer.
- No practice on Monday, 11 June for Pulliam groups. This includes the Swim School students. Swim school make up lesson will be on Friday, 8 June.

Registration is done by mail

All registration for the Swim School is done by mail. Forms were mailed to families in the Saluki database earlier in the spring but if you need a form you can always call Saluki HQ and we'll send you one. Or you can visit Swimsaluki.com and download a swim school brochure.

Classes start on 4 June

The first session of lessons begins on Monday, 4 June and continues through four 2-week sessions until 2 August. Classes are offered Monday through Thursday for two weeks at several times. Three class periods are offered each day: 5:00, 5:45 and 6:30p.



Children registering for swim school classes must be at least 4 years old on the first day of the session they are registering for.

Saluki swimmers had a great meet recently at the 2001 Saluki Invitational. Practically every Saluki turned in several best times. Full results are available at Swimsaluki.com but here is a brief summary:

Hvidston takes Big 'K' award. Justin Hvidston won the Big 'K' award beating out Ryan McDonald 189 to 149 seconds.

15 new records. In one of the most record breaking meets ever Saluki swimmers turned in 15 new long course records. Bob Byars set 7 of them, Brad Byars set 4, Paige Saliba set 2 and Lindsey Kolar and Jason Sigler both set 1.

Saluki Open (indoor events) cancelled

The indoor portion of the Saluki Open Water weekend has been cancelled.

Open Water Challenge

Registration for the annual *Open Water Challenge* at Little Grassy lake is still open. There are races for all ages starting with 10 & unders and going up from there.

This is a fun and challenging event for swimmers in a very different environment from what they are used to.
