Saluki Swim Club Finishes 8th in 2010 Saluki International

Fifty-nine Saluki Swim Club swimmers competed in the 2010 Saluki International held last weekend at the Shea Natatorium. The team finished 8th overall out of 17 teams competing in the meet. In all Saluki swimmers achieved 343 personal best times in races

throughout the weekend. This amounted to personal best times in 85% of their races. Saluki swimmers also achieved 99 B times, 87 BB times, 19 A times, 14 AA times, 7 AAA times, and 2 AAAA times. Nineteen Saluki swimmers (Bethany Akinduro, Cody Bailey, Amelia Coello, Sara Coello, Stephen Cohen, Camille Davis, Ryan Hall, Calvin Kolar, Ashlee Kuan, Cameron Kuan, Jerry Kuhnert, Luke Lauzon, Darlene Sao, Joan Shang, Austyn Sigler, Jacob Stone, Emily Stroud, Steven Thompson, and Kelsie Walker) achieved 81 Ozark Championship qualifying times. In addition, Camille Davis, Calvin Kolar and Kelsie Walker achieved 6 Sectional Championship times.
