Fall 2010 Session Registration Will Open on Monday, July 19

Registration for the Fall 2010 Session will open on Monday, July 19. The deadline for returning swimmers to register is Friday, August 6. Any new swimmers, who did not participate with Saluki Swim Club last year, need to participate in the Evaluation Night on Monday, July 26 at 6:30 at Pulliam Hall Pool. *In order to register for the Fall Session, you must have your account paid in full!* If you have any questions regarding your account, please contact Coach Jay at 457-1103.

In order to register, access the Registration link on the Racing Team webpage (or the link will be available on the Homepage starting July 19) and fill out the form. Then you will need to mail in the 2010-2011 paperwork, 2011 USA registration paperwork and your registration check of \$110 per swimmer. The 2010-2011 registration paperwork will be mailed to returning families with their July account statement on July 15. The 2010-2011 paperwork will also be available on the archive page on the team website. For each Fall session (or your first session on the team), each swimmer is required to submit paperwork and pay a \$110 registration fee. The \$110 registration fee is not an additional fee. The registration fee will be applied to your Fall session fees (think of it as a down payment on your Fall session fees).

For new swimmers who wish to join Saluki Swim Club, after your evaluation you will receive an email detailing your group placement. The email will also give the specifics regarding your deadline to mail in your registration fee of \$110 per swimmer.

Evaluation Night for the Fall Session is Monday, July 26

Ozark Long Course Championships Will be Held At SIU

The 2010 Ozark Long Course Championships will be held at the SIU Rec Center on Friday, July 30 through Sunday, August 1. Saluki Swim Club will co-host this event with FAST. The meet will be a 3 day prelim and final meet with a morning session each day from 8:30 am to approximately 12:30 pm and a finals session from 6 pm to approximately 8:30pm. We will need help filling our half of the positions in the meet (especially on Sunday evening when we must fill all positions!) *Please volunteer to help us even if you do not have a swimmer in the meet!* This meet will provide funds that benefit Saluki Swim Club! Saluki Swimmers Compete Against Strong Competition in the CSP Summer Invitational

Eight Saluki Swim Club swimmers competed in the 82nd Annual CSP Summer Invitational in Clayton, MO June 25-27. In all, Saluki swimmers achieved 14 B, 16 BB, 2 A, 9 AA, 11 AAA, 34 Ozark qualifying times, and 2 Sectional qualifying times in the meet. Saluki swimmers also swam 36 best times in the meet. Twelve year old Jacob Stone won the high point for the 11-12 boys age group. Jacob won the 200 IM, 50, 100, and 200 free. Jacob finished 2nd in the 400 free and 3rd in the 50 fly, 50 back, 50 breast and 100 breast. Other Saluki swimmers who scored points in the meet included: Stephen Cohen (18 years old) – finished 12th in the 200 breast and 14th in the 100 breast; Kelsie Walker (14 years old) – finished 2nd in the 200 and 400 free, 3rd in the 100 free, 5th in the 400 IM, 6th in the 200 fly, 8th in the 50 free, 9th in the 200 IM, and 11th in the 100 fly. Stephen Cohen, Ryan Hall, Ashlee Kuan, Austyn Sigler, Jacob Stone, Kelsie Walker, and Taylor Yucus achieved Ozark qualifying times in the meet.
